A 4-to-6-month intensive program for export ready NSW companies, who are looking to expand and diversify in their sector and international market.

The program features:

- Online workshops, market intelligence briefings and cultural training
- Potential partner introductions and business matching
- Market visits programs, in-market assistance and logistical support
- Ongoing advice and follow up from a dedicated Export Adviser from Investment NSW
- Access to the NSW Trade and Investment Commissioner in-market

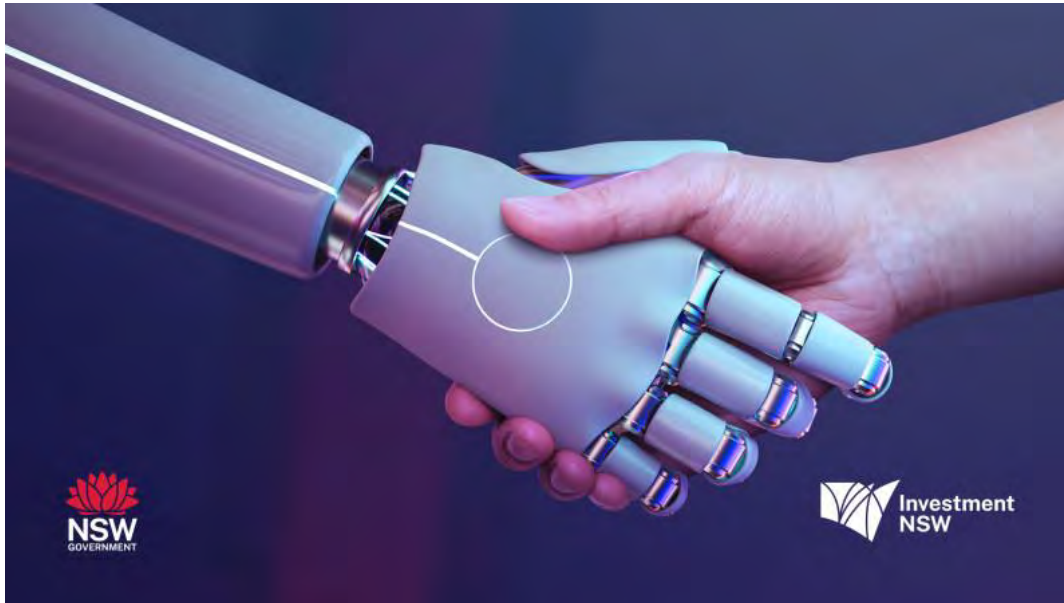

The MVP (Minimum Viable Product) Ventures Program



The MVP Ventures Program is a grant program that supports startups and innovative SMEs in the product lifecycle between early-stage research and mature investment opportunities to drive the commercialisation of highly innovative and new products.

Key information:

- Grant amount: From \$25,000 to \$50,000
- Applications Round 2 is open until 28 February 2025 (or until funding is exhausted, whichever occurs first)

Application process:

- The Program has a two-stage application process, consisting of an Expression of Interest (EOI) and a detailed application.
- Applications are considered on a non-competitive basis against the eligibility and assessment criteria.
